Entrance Requirement

- Any Christian home school student who regularly attends church, whose parents attend church, and has a pastor or youth pastor recommendation (from a church of like faith). Seventh grade students and higher must interview with the pastor and/or principal.
- Families must fill out a standard ICA application, as well as the above registration. This is for legal purposes.
- Provide copies of a doctor's physical examination and immunization report.
- Pay a \$50 registration fee (this covers miscellaneous expenses such as student accident and sports insurance)

Policies and Procedures

- All families must read, agree to follow, and sign a statement of cooperation in the ICA parent/student handbook.
- If a student or parent is found to be uncooperative with our established policies, that family's participation in the program will be terminated.
- Chapel once per week will be required by all who participate in the program
- Students should be dropped off at the front entrance no earlier than fifteen minutes before their scheduled class/activity. They need to sign in at the receptionist desk as a home school student.
- Within five minutes of the end of the class/activity, students should report back to the front lobby and await their transportation home. The student will then sign themselves out with the receptionist.
- Discipline issues will be dealt with the same as a full-time ICA student (see handbook).
- Dress code for boys will be as follows: navy, white, or light blue polo shirts (solid), and either navy blue pants or khaki pants (no cargo style pants or faded pants). Dress or dark casual shoes are acceptable. No sneakers, except for sports activities. On chapel days, a shirt, tie, dress pants, and dress shoes will be required. For hair standards and grooming standards, please refer to the handbook.
- Dress code for girls will be as follows: navy, white, or light blue polo shirts (solid), and either navy blue skirts (knee length), or khaki skirts (knee length). Casual / dress shoes may be worn, but no sneakers except for athletic activities. For all other requirements, please refer to the handbook.
- Home school students may bring a cell phone, but must turn it completely off before entering the academic area of the school. After the class, the student may return to the lobby and use the cell phone again.
