

Nursery Parent Volunteer Description

Parents are an important part of our nursery ministry at St. John's. We therefore ask them to volunteer periodically in the nursery.

Ministry Description

Accountability:

The nursery Parent Volunteer is accountable to the Nursery Supervisor and ultimately accountable to the Director of Children's Ministry.

Qualifications:

1. Caring, nurturing and friendly with the ability to relate positively to children and adults.
2. Dependable and reliable.
3. Must use positive and preventative approach to behavior management. No physical discipline is allowed.
4. Must have a biannual Washington State Patrol background check. (Forms available in the nursery).

Responsibilities:

1. Pray regularly for fellow caregivers, children and families.
2. Carefully tend to and care for the children in the nursery at all times during scheduled time.
3. Communicate supply and facility needs to the Nursery Supervisor.
4. Trade with another parent when scheduled on a day that has a conflict.
5. Arrive 15 minutes early to help with check-in.
6. Follow the guidance of the Nursery Supervisor.
7. Stay in nursery until a replacement arrives or the Nursery Supervisor gives clearance.
8. Attend annual Nursery Volunteer training meetings.
