## Adoration Chapel—Snow Emergency

The State of Indiana has created a standard and consistent travel advisory system that coincides with the alerts issued by the National Weather Service, beginning with an advisory, watch and warning. Whenever the city of Batesville is on a (Level 2) **Travel Watch—Orange** snow emergency (Conditions are threatening to the safety of the public. Only essential travel is recommended i.e., to and from work, emergency situations, etc.), adoration of the Blessed Sacrament must temporarily be discontinued, and the Adoration Chapel itself must be locked to properly secure the Blessed Sacrament. This especially applies to daytime adorers who do not have keys to the chapel. (The chapel will be unlocked during the day upon individual request, however. Call the office or the rectory before you arrive.) For evening adorers who have keys, the same key will unlock the chapel door, and you can go to adoration at your own safe discretion. Adoration will continue as usual as soon as the **Watch** is lifted. (NOTE: Batesville follows Ripley County, but a travel alert can be issued for just the city.)
