



Dear Church Family,

In 1929, plans developed to plant a Baptist church in the "Hill" section of Augusta. In 1955, recounting the motivation for planting our church, our historian wrote, "People of faith and consecration went to church, it's true; but the time had come to bring churches closer to the people. God always is practical." I love reading about the history of our church. Our historian tells us, "God led out from the City and other parts of the Country, a group of Bible-loving people who were greatly desiring to exalt 'Christ' and the 'Bible." This group of people were willing to take a risk and God has used their faith to change countless lives.

Over the 80 plus years of our church's existence faith-filled people have sought to do whatever it takes in order to reach people for Jesus. They built buildings. They started small group Bible studies. They started children's Bible classes. They gave money to state and international missions. They went on mission trips all over the world. They planted churches. I could go on and on. The point is that effort was made to reach people for Jesus Christ.

We are at a unique time in the life of our church. We have the opportunity to once again consider what it will take in order to reach more people in our community for Christ. A few weeks ago, I sent out a report that explains our need to create a new life cycle. In the report, I proposed the idea to create a second Sunday morning service that may enable us to reach more people in our community. I tried to anticipate many of the questions you would have and attempted to address them in the report. I am sure there are other questions that need to be answered. On Wednesday, September 10th at 6:15pm we will meet in the Social Hall to have an open forum to address those questions. I hope you will attend this forum. The motivation behind creating a new life cycle is to exalt Christ. Our mission has not changed since our founding. We will continue to seek out ways to bring the church to the people. Please join me in praying that God will give us wisdom in the days ahead as we seek to be fruitful in the ministry God has entrusted to us in our city.


