- ▶ Learn to develop your capacity to translate values and strategies into productive actions

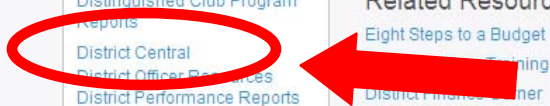

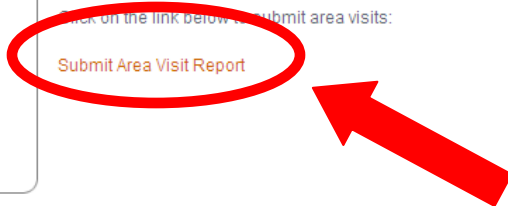


