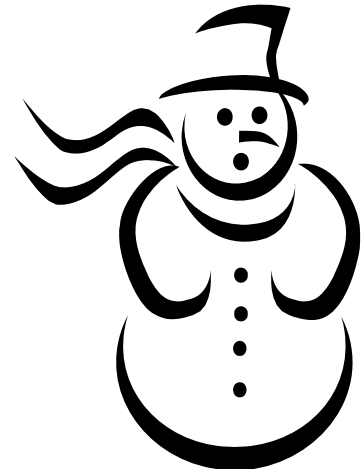


District 36 Winter TLI Policy

- **President, VPE, VPM, and VPPR** MUST attend the winter training for their specific office to receive credit for their club under the DCP plan even if they attended Summer training.
- **Treasurer, Secretary, and SAA** who did NOT attend TLI training in Summer MUST attend the 2-hour core training for their officer position at Winter training.
- **Treasurer, Secretary and SAA** who DID attend TLI training in the Summer can attend any core officer class in the winter to earn credit.
- Newly elected or appointed club officers since **January 1, 2012** MUST attend their core officer training class, even if their predecessor attended training at Summer training.



To Earn TLI Credits



Attendees must sign the class roster in the room as well as return the completed registration form to the desk before they leave the training to earn credit for their participation.

If you hold the same office in more than one club, you can earn credit for all your clubs at one Winter TLI training session; you MUST include information for all your clubs on the registration form when you attend training.

If you hold different club offices in more than one club, you MUST attend winter TLI training for each officer position to earn credit for each club.

Club Recognition for Training

- **DCP Status** – at least 4 individual club officers MUST be trained at both Summer and Winter TLI sessions.
- **All Year Dream Team Status** – All 7 individual officers MUST be trained at BOTH Summer and Winter TLI sessions
- **Winter Dream Team Status** – All 7 individual officers MUST be trained at Winter TLI session
