Frequently Asked Questions

1. How does my child get to camp?

Each church provides its own transportation to camp. This year, camp is located at Rolling Hills Conference Center in Calera, AL. The address is:
521 Highway 304
Calera, AL 35404

2. Will there be a nurse on hand?

Yes. We will have two Registered Nurses available at all times.

3. What do I do with my child's medication?

Please bring it to check-in in a Ziploc bag with the child's name written on it with a Sharpie marker, and with instructions for administering it. The Camp Nurser will administer medication at the appropriate times.

4. Do I need to send money for snacks?

Yes. Each child will need to bring money for snacks (no more than \$20 per child), and the Snack Shack will be open during the afternoons for the children to purchase snacks. The snack purchases will be monitored by the leaders, and kids will not be permitted to "blow" all their money the first day.

5. Is there a lifeguard at the swimming pool?

Yes. Certified lifeguards will be at the swimming areas at all times.
