What will we be covering this term?

1st Half Term: During the course of the first term, pupils will be learning vocabulary associated with different places, and the external environment. Pupils will also focus more on reading sentences with pictures.

2nd Half Term: In this term, pupils will continue to practice how to ask and respond to questions. Pupils will also learn basic skills on sentence building and on writing Arabic.

How will my child be assessed this term?

Pupils will be assessed in the following four areas: Speaking and listening - their use and understanding of basic phrases and vocabulary. Linking sounds to letters - phonetic knowledge will be assessed through a written test, where children are required to identify letters correctly through sound. Reading - at this stage their ability to read simple sentences with the help of pictures. Writing - pupils' ability to form letters correctly, and copy out text will be assessed.

How can I help my child in this subject?

Pupils will be provided with reading and written homework once a week, which they are required to complete for the date their homework is due. Parents are required to both instruct and oversee their child's performance. The task provided is an extension and reinforcement of what has been covered in class, and therefore pupils should complete their work independently.
