## VBS PRE-REGISTRATION LETTER JUNE 20-24, 2011

*Dear Parents:*

*I would like to personally invite your child/children to attend our Vacation Bible School at First Baptist Church this summer. **It will be held June 20<sup>th</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup>, from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon each day.** There will be departments for rising four year olds through rising sixth graders. (Children must be of age to attend a four year old pre-school in the Fall to attend.) We have several departments for each of our younger age groups. Departments for four-year-olds through second grade will be limited to a maximum of 16 children in each.*

*If you are interested in having your child/children attend our morning VBS, **please fill out the attached form and return it to First Baptist Church or your Day Care facility (those listed below) by Tuesday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2011.** (See below for the list of Day Cares where our church bus will be picking up children).*

*If your child will be in Day Care during the summer, we will be providing transportation each day to and from VBS from The Boys and Girls Club, both Excel Campuses, and My School. The children will be returned to their respective Day Cares after VBS around 12:30pm on Monday through Thursday. On Friday they will return around 1:15pm after our Hot Dog lunch. **This year, if your child rides the bus to VBS they will be required to ride the bus back to their day care.** Please indicate on your registration form if your child needs to be picked up.*

*Commencement for our morning VBS will be on Friday, June 24<sup>th</sup> at 11:30 a.m. Parents will go through our Joint Worship Service with us and then go to their child's classroom to see what their child has been doing all week. A hot dog lunch will follow in the Family Life Center for everyone.*

***Our VBS community outreach this year will be Martha's Mission. We are asking each child to please bring a can vegetable, a can meat, a bag/box of rice, or a cake mix with a can of icing to take to Martha's Mission when his/her class visits. Martha's Mission is an emergency food pantry for families in crisis in Carteret County. Every month, the mission provides food for more than 300 families, senior citizens, and mentally/ physically challenged persons. Martha's Mission operates strictly on donations. Volunteers help to sort and distribute the incoming food. ALL OFFERING COLLECTED DURING VBS WILL BE GIVEN TO MARTHA'S MISSION.***
