Are you ready to begin a relationship with Christ right now?

Here are 8 Biblical steps showing how to get off to the right **S T A R T**.

<b>S</b>	<b>Stop trusting in yourself</b> and what you can do (PRO 28:26)
	<b>Start trusting in Jesus</b> and what he has already done. (PRO 3:5-6)
<b>T</b>	<b>Tell Jesus</b> that you are sorry for your sins and invite Him to come and <b>live inside of you.</b> (1 JN 1:9) (REV 3:20)
<b>A</b>	<b>Ask Jesus to become your Savior and your Lord</b> (which means being #1 in your life) (1 TIM 1:15) (ROM 10:9-10)
<b>R</b>	<b>Repent and turn away</b> from everything God and the Bible call sin (ACTS 3:19)
<b>T</b>	<b>Totally commit yourself to obeying Christ</b> every day for the rest of your life (MAT 16:25)

If after reading the above 8 areas you are not willing to yield to God in any one of them, we recommend that you do not commit yourself to Christ until you are prepared to do it on His terms.

As in the earthly marriage, a commitment without carefully counting the cost will eventually end in disappointment and failure.

If, on the other hand, you are ready to make this commitment, we encourage you to begin your relationship with Christ in prayer.

Sincerely pray the prayer in the red box aloud as outlined Romans 10:9-10.

*"Lord Jesus,*

*I want to stop trusting in myself and what I can do and start trusting in what you have already done when you died for me on the cross. I know that I am a sinner and I am sorry for my sins. I ask you to forgive me and I invite you to come and live inside of me. I want you to be my Savior and my Lord which means being #1 in my life. I want to Repent and Turn away from everything you and the Bible call sin and I totally commit myself to obeying you everyday, for the rest of my life.*

*Thank You Jesus."*

In order for your new personal relationship with God to grow, it is essential that you:

- Spend some time each day praying and worshipping God. (1 THES 5:17-18)
- Daily read the Bible - Begin with the Gospel of John. (1 PE 2:2)
- Find a church that teaches the Bible as 100% the Word of God and encourages a personal relationship with Jesus. (HEB 10:25)
- Begin to develop friendships with sincere Christians. (1 JN 1:7)
- Tell other people about your new relationship with God. (MAT 4:19)
