Augusta Family Dentistry houses one of 400 I-Cat Cone Beam Scanners in the world. Augusta Family Dentistry is also one of the first thirty offices in the world to own and utilize the E4D. These distinctions have brought colleagues from Oklahoma, Texas, New Mexico and Arizona to Augusta Family Dentistry in order to study how Dr. Mitsch and his staff utilize these technologies.
