



Easy Care Spa Start-up

Congratulations on owning the finest spa in the world.

Keeping your spa bright and clear not only protects your spa and equipment it also insures your full enjoyment of your spa experience. **Southwest Spas and Price Busters Pool and Spa supply** will make your spa easy to maintain by simply following our weekly easy care guidelines.

Filling Spa

1. Remove one spa cartridge filter, place hose in bottom of filter compartment, remove two bleeder valves located in filter compartment area to allow air lines to bleed to prevent air lock at start up. Run water hose at maximum pressure until spa water reaches mid tile level.

2. Reinstall bleeder valves and screw down tightly. Place cartridge filter back in compartment.

Turn both jets pumps on high and continue to turn off and on until pumps run steady and all air has cleared the line* **be patient, this may take a few minutes.**

3. Add 2oz. pak of granular chlorine (provided in owner's manual pak) or 2oz. of spa sanitizer, this is used for initial start up.

4. Next day test water and adjust alkalinity/ph with spa increaser or decreaser. Always adjust alkalinity first and ph second.

Spa is ready to be used. Enjoy!

Weekly

Shock spa twice per week with **non chlorine shock** *Be very leery of "less expensive" shock/oxidizers that contain undisclosed contaminants (glues & binders) that will clog & ruin your spa filters and pumps which can **VOID YOUR SPA WARRANTY.**

Test water and adjust ph/alkalinity as needed with increaser or decreaser

The proper ph/alkalinity level should be between 7.2-7.8 Recommended alkalinity level is between 80-120.

High ph reduces spa sanitizer efficiency, clouds water, promotes scale and stain formation on surfaces equipment and interferes with filter operation. Low ph is equally damaging and cause equipment corrosion, skin and eye irritation and rapid sanitizer dissipation.

Due to Arizona's' high water mineral and calcium content it is highly recommended to use our metal sequestrant to prevent the damaging effects of these metals on your spa shell and equipment. This metal sequestrant should be added at initial start up at each refill of spa (3-4 months.) is recommended.

Super chlorinate weekly with granular di-chlor.(2-3 OZ.). **DO NOT** use tablets or liquid chlorine. This will void your warranty.

Monthly

Remove cartridge filters and soak or spray filters with recommended **filter cleaning solution.** Why is this necessary? All soaps, body oils & lotions, cosmetics, deodorants,

body fluids, perspiration, detergents, clog filters and are trapped in your filters. Without recommended cleaning (not just hosing off with water) you will experience cloudy & *contaminated* water, low jet pressure, and unnecessary service calls.

It is highly recommended to use a natural enzyme that breaks down the above oils and contaminants before they adhere to your filters and surface (ring around the tub)

Six Month

VISION-Sanitizing Cartridge (white bag or purple disc) located on the top of cartridge filter. The 500 grams of silver in the Vision cartridge, continuously kills 99.96% of bacteria on contact, reduces the need for harsh chemicals and will not leave an odor or chemical smell. Vision works in conjunction with your Ultra Management system (ozone) to provide pristine water.

Helpful Hints

Pre-dissolve chemicals in a container and spread evenly into spa when jets are on and allow to run for a minimum of a half hour after adding any chemicals to spa.

Depending on bather load and frequency of use you may need to follow these steps twice a week.

Warning

Never use Bromine, pool chemicals or other household products in your spa. This could ruin your spa surface and equipment and void your spa warranty. Minerals and metals in your water can become very aggressive in your spa and cause severe damage if not balanced properly.

Don't be shy, bring your water in for a free detailed water analysis and let us help you with your water chemistry information and questions. We have been in the business for 28 years. Don't trust an amateur in the industry to check your water chemistry.

Every Two Years

Change out your **OZONE BULB** because it is now dead. If you have started to experience a substance that looks like skin floating or white particles, your ozone bulb has died out. This is a patented ozone system with a degassing chamber that allows you to relax and breath easy while bacteria is constantly being killed. Without the Ultra Pure Ozone Purification system, you would need to constantly be using chemicals such as Bromine and Chlorine to keep it bacteria free. Remember that this is a small body of water and needs to be maintained in order to prevent bacteria growth that will later develop into you or one of your guests becoming ill, getting a rash, pseudomonas, etc.
