# AKUSE PRISON

On this trip to Ghana West Africa our team had the opportunity to minister in the Akuse Prison. All of the years that I have gone to Ghana I have never gone into the prison system. One of the Local pastors asked if we would come and minister the Word and bring some donations to those that are seldom visited. I said yes without reservation. It was not until we were on our way to Africa that questions were presented to me about our safety and security measures. Well bless God He had already taken care of that. Thank God there are those He sends with me that are looking out for my safety and well being. I do get excited at times for new opportunities and new doors.

I am only five feet one half inches tall but as you can see I had to bend over to get through the door that led into the inside of the prison hall way. It was a space about nine feet by nine feet. Very tight for all of us getting in there. Eleven team members were in that hall way plus the prison personnel. We shared a word of encouragement and Apostle Daryl O'neil also ministered to the male population. The few female prisoners were allowed to come in and hear the Word. Very depressed situation. The prisoner population is approximately 325. The donations were sent from your our partners. The toothpaste, toothbrushes, the deodorant, soap, shampoo and scripture portions were greatly appreciated. THANKS PARTNERS.!

# AKATENG VILLAGE UPDATE

.Going into Akateng is and was a very bumpy experience. Most of the road into that village was not paved or graded. Many ruts were there and if our Bus driver had not been experienced we could have had damage to the 21 passenger bus we were riding in. We had the girls (smile) tied down so there would not be much bouncing.

The village is one and one half hours on the other side of Asesewa. So we were at the end of the road, the next stop was the Volta River. This village has no running water and no electricity. These two utilities are being brought into that village but as yet not connected to the homes. A lot of homes in that area are made of mud. One local pastor, that attends the Video Ministerial School at the CCIM Training Center, invited us to the area. We had promised we would come and we did. Please pray for that village there is much needed there. We do not hear of outside ministries traveling into that area to share the gospel with the pastors there. There is need for unity among the pastors.

Below are pictures of the team ministering to the adults as well as children that had gathered for the service. There is such a hunger for the word of God among the people. In this village two interpreters are needed because several dialects are spoken in this area. So once you have spoken then two interpreters speak before you get to the next part of your message. God did they get the message?

We will have a fashion show with outdoor canopies set up so the guest can be comfortable and have refreshments. The Dignitaries will be invited plus the friends and families. The girls will model garments they have designed and constructed. I am excited just writing about this.

Several of the girls have already made garments for themselves and some people in their villages have asked them to make garments for them. There is so much excitement in the area that people are coming daily asking can their daughter be in the next class. We give God all praise, honor and glory for what He has done and is doing in Asewewa and the surrounding villages. Just look at what you our partners have done. We need your sponsorship. **School started July 5, 2010**, such progress.!
