Report of Coordinating Council (none)

Review of September Minutes - passed

Discussion Items:

Bingo- help still needed – more parishioners

- When Roxanne was gone, profits dropped
- Need for money cashiers from our church
- Approximately 60 people attend weekly
- 15% of church's budget comes from bingo
- If she does not get help, no more bingo
- Father suggest putting out another list for volunteers and 4 strategies:

1. Involve ministries
2. Approach new people personally
3. Go through volunteer list and call
4. Council members do every other month.

COC Haiti participation

- Priest in Haiti found benefactor in Canada
- They have been doing renovations, construction and additions
- Priest got money from Mayor of town for 10 pews to be built
- He had a summer camp for the children
- Needs and challenges: 500-600 children were being fed lunch, that stopped
- Crucifixion parishioner pays for Internet for 1 year - \$50.00 a month
- Need more pews and some fans
- Need benches and tables for cafeteria, also bowls and utensils
- Routine announcements made at Holy Trinity
- Wish List - feed children everyday (\$50,000 to \$60,000 a year)
- Main purpose is to build up the church making it center of activity.

Report of the Pastor

- Father explained the 2011 Annual Finance Report and Capital Campaign
- He will educate the parishioners on importance of offertory
- Transparency of our funds
- Spoke about weekday Masses – rotating schedule within the cluster by January 1st
 - Council will review schedule.
