Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes  
May 16, 2011

Fr. Kevin opened the meeting with an opening prayer.

Discussion/Approval of April Minutes:

Action Items:

- Next meeting scheduled for June 20, 2011. We will not have a July or August meeting.

Discussion Items:

- Council elections will be announced during weekend Masses on 5/21/11 and 5/22/11 by Lorraine on Saturday and Steve on Sunday. Nominations will take place 6/4/11 and 6/5/11. Photos and Bios 6/4/11 through 6/18/11. The ballots and voting by Dick Morsey and Steve Schaffer from 6/18/11 through 6/19/11. The winners will be published 6/25/11 and 6/26/11.
- We discussed and need feedback from Fr. Rich on how to proceed with the Pastoral Plan. Is the Council to focus on one priority goal or are we still on the path of revising the plan developed last summer by the Council? Need clarification from Fr. Rich in order to proceed for the September meeting.
- Gail has now presented the Haiti project to the Staff and Council. Discussed a bulletin notice to introduce the project to the Parish and at this time requesting only prayers.
- Mass Schedule Proposals being met with acceptance and positive feedback. The distance seems to be the only concern. In addition, if Religious Education is from 9:00-10:15 should Mass at Crucifixion begin at 10:30 or 11:00. Among Council present a brief discussion, but no strong feeling one way or the other.

- Memorial Day flags will be purchased for distribution at weekend Masses by Dave Papak. Discussion also about Father's Day pins and Lorraine will investigate appropriate gift. Both of these gifts to the parishioners are on behalf of the Parish Council.

- Brief discussion about a Day of Retreat for the Parish Council. Fr. Rich might be thinking about this as a Fall event. Lorraine suggested St. Anthony's.
