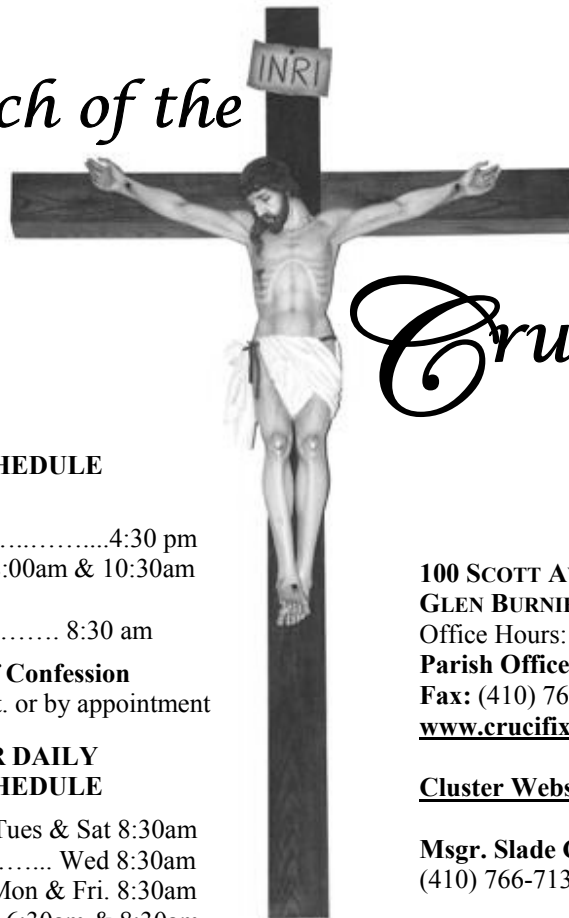

New parishioners are invited to pick up a welcome packet and registration form in the church foyer after Mass from one of our Welcome ministers.

SACRAMENTS

Baptism: Celebrated on first Sunday of the month. Parents must attend preparation classes. Please call the parish office to make arrangements.

Marriage: Couples should contact the priest before a setting a date for their wedding in order to ensure church availability. Participation in a marriage preparation program is required and couples are encouraged to begin preparations 9-12 months prior to their wedding date.

Anointing of the Sick: This sacrament of healing is intended for those who are ill or infirm. Parishioners scheduled for surgery are encouraged to contact the parish office prior to hospital admission and always in cases of emergency.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Religious Education Classes are held for children age PK-4 to 8th grade on Sunday mornings from 9:15 to 10:15am at Marley Elementary School.

Children's Ministry is held during the Liturgy of the Word at the 10:30am Mass and offers children ages 4 years old – 5th grade activities and reflections based on the Sunday readings. (Note: This does not replace your child's regular Religious Education classes.)

First Reconciliation and First Eucharist: In order to receive these sacraments, children must be enrolled in the Religious Education program for two years prior to beginning the preparation classes in 2nd grade. Please call the parish office for more information.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is celebrated in the 9th grade. Candidates must be Baptized, have already received Eucharist and Reconciliation, and be enrolled in the Religious Education program at least one year prior to beginning the preparation program in 9th grade.

High School Youth Ministry: Please call the Parish Office for information.

From Time to Time with Fr. Kevin

I am calling this column From Time to Time because I know I will not be writing to you every weekend. However, previous experience has taught me this is a great way to communicate information to the entire parish. Fr. Rich, Fr. Jesse and I have taken this first month to get settled in. We all want to thank you for your words or welcome and support, and your patience during this time of transition. This should be a year filled with many blessings.

Recently we entered into a relationship with a professional answering service to handle after hour emergencies. Currently, each of the three linked parishes has a different phone system, and until recently the procedures for after hour emergencies varied from parish to parish. Crucifixion, Good Shepherd and Holy Trinity now have an emergency line which will be shared among all three parishes, and answered by a live operator. If you have a health emergency requiring the presence of a priest (funeral, death of a parishioner, need for anointing etc.) please call **(410) 553-2893**. The operator will ask which parish from which you are calling and then forward your message to the on-duty priest. Unless your call comes on a Thursday which is my day off or during vacation, I will normally be handling emergencies for Crucifixion. Fr. Rich and Fr. Jesse will be available as back-up if I am not available. Please make note of this new number. All other after-hour needs should be handled through the parish voice-mail system or by email. Speaking of email you may now email me at **kfarmer@crucifixionparish.org**.

I hope you have noticed the new garden in front of the Church recently completed by Adrian Flores. Adrian was up against a tight deadline to complete his Eagle Scout project before his 18th birthday.
