Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes
April 13, 2010

Fr. DeAscanis opened the meeting with prayer.

Fr. DeAscanis reported;

Steve Schaffer reported that efforts are still on going to get a better street sign to identify Scott Ave. on B&A Blvd. and a larger sign identifying Church of the Crucifixion on Cooper Ave.
