Pastoral Council Meeting

08 December 2009

Fr. Jarboe opened the meeting with an opening prayer

Fr. Jarboe gave a summary of the parish staffing for Crucifixion and Good Sheppard, the winter relief effort for Holy Trinity, Good Sheppard, and Crucifixion, and his upcoming move to the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen.

Kathy Johnson gave a report of the Cluster Coordinating Council. She talked about the Guidelines and policy if there is no Priest available for Mass and the needs of the cluster.

Jim Sadler reported that the link on the parish website for the Pastoral Council is complete. The parish will be changing its web host which will allow for more flexibility at a cheaper cost.

Sandy Klohr discussed the upcoming events for the children of the parish, the proposed institution of the Traveling Chalice to promote vocations, and the establishment of an Evangelization Committee.

Lorraine Jacukiewicz informed the group that \$400 was spent on turkeys this past Thanksgiving. Winter Relief at Crucifixion will be the week of 08 Feb. 10, and the Bid for Hope, which benefits Arundel House of Hope, be on 31 Jan. 10 and Tickets will go on sale soon. Also that people from Crucifixion are filling the gap for a few nights this month at the homeless shelter due to staff shortages.

Bob Giesey indicated that the shed will be cleaned out and reorganized in December along with cleaning of the gutters and a cost estimate will be worked up for some kind of gutter guard for the church.

Fr. DeAscanis gave the closing prayer for the evening.
