On May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> all students in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade will take the NJASK Test. The results of this test will be used to assist in providing an appropriate educational program for your child. It is very important that your child come to school well rested and that your child has had a good breakfast. It is also important that they arrive to school on time. **Students arriving after 7:50am will not be admitted into the testing rooms.** Students will be required to make-up any section they miss.

On the day of testing your child **will not be allowed to have any backpacks, electronic devices (cell phones, cameras, ipods, etc.), or any additional personal or academic materials** in the testing room. **Being caught with any of these items will result in their immediate removal from the testing room and their test booklet will be voided.**

This guide was produced by the New Jersey Department of Education and includes important information about the assessment program. Please take time to review this guide with your child.
