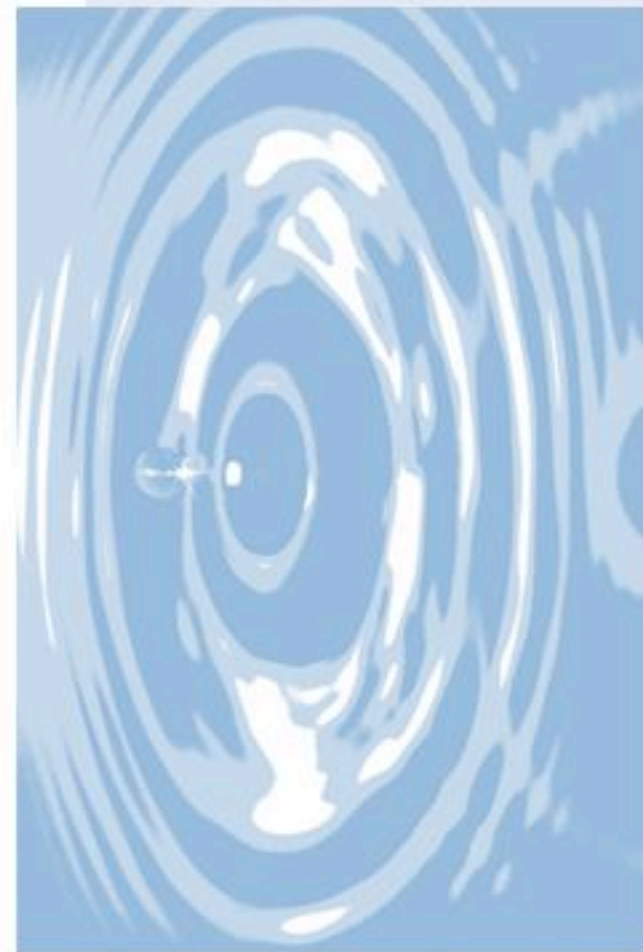

12 Group Sessions

Each student will attend and participate in 12 weekly group sessions which will introduce the important concepts of recovery and abstinence using motivational interviewing and cognitive behavioral techniques.

6 Individual Sessions

Each student will participate in at least 6 individual sessions which will include direct counseling concerning substance use, abuse, and dependence and related life areas. The goal is the student's personal journey of a commitment to abstinence.

6 Family Sessions

The student's family is the most important support along their journey. These sessions focus on the family unit and the strength it can bring to the student as he works to overcome substance use or dependence.

Random Screening

Each student will receive a minimum of three random drug screens to determine and celebrate their progress in abstinence. If the student passes the 3 screens consecutively, no further screens are required.
