The Board of Presbytery (Board One) also approved Angela Tucker and Monica Stevenson as officers of the corporation regarding banking and financial concerns.

Per the Bylaws of CHSC, the president, vice president, and Board Members elected/appointed as of August 2008, serve a six (6) year term (no limit on number of terms) and national department presidents serve a four (4) year (no limit on number of terms).

Inducted into the Bishops' Council were Bishop R.L. Swain, Bishop E.L. McBride, Bishop Herman Ishmael Jr., and Bishop W.T. Smith all of whom have served as bishops in CHSC at least 20 years and are at least 75 years old. The Bishops' Council serves as counsel to the presiding bishop and Board One and the members have a lifetime status within the organization. This council is self-governing and receives the highest honors due to them at all times.
