Services Available

The services available at our cemetery includes: Private Cremation, Private Burial & Group Burial for your pet. The burial of human cremains with your pet or pets is available. These services are available for when the need arises or may be planned out months to years in advance (pre-need planning will lock in the current prices for your future needs, when paid in advance.).

Private Cremation

Rolling Acres has only performed private cremations. Each pet is done individually. You may be present for the cremation or have a memorial service and viewing prior to the cremation. This process will usually take a minimum of one day & depends on the current demand for the crematory. With a higher demand for the cremation service, it may take up to 5 to 7 days.

Once the process is completed, you will be called & told that your pet's cremains are ready to be picked up. You may pick your pet's cremains up at your convenience during our business hours. A simple white box is available for taking the cremains home or you may select an urn that suits your pet's personality. A wide variety of urns are available starting at \$8.00. Some urns have room for a photo or the photo may be engraved on slate, metal or porcelain.



The cremation price is based on your pet's weight. Due to the change in the price of natural gas this price may vary from time to time. Please call for the current price. (402)483-7001.

If you would prefer to bury the cremains at the cemetery, that is available. Burial of cremains start at: \$65.00 for a flower garden mini plot or \$85.00 for a mini lawn plot. This price includes the plot, a interment fee for the burial & an endowment care fee for upkeep.

Also available is scattering the cremains at our cemetery.

Private Burial

Private burial is an individual body burial of your pet at the cemetery. The cost for our private burials start at \$190.00. This price includes the plot, an interment fee for the burial, & an endowment care fee for upkeep. The private burial is usually completed within one week depending on the weather. (Wet & cold weather can delay burial.)

With our private burials, the owners may be present for the burial of your pet with a viewing or memorial service prior to the burial.

We have a large selection of caskets, memorial markers, and flower vases available for use at the cemetery or at home.



Group Burial

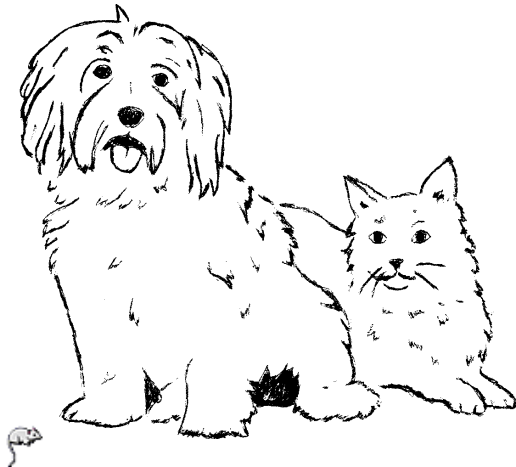
Group burial is a burial of your pet with other pets in a communal grave at the cemetery. This type of burial is a closed burial & will be an unmarked grave on the cemetery grounds. Group burial start at \$50.00, cost is based on the weight of your pet.

Pick Up or Removal

We can pick up your pet's body from your veterinarian's office or remove him/her from your home. The pick up or removal fee is based on your pet's weight & the distance from Lincoln. You may choose to bring your pet's body to our cemetery yourself, so you may say your final goodbye in our viewing room.

Human Cremains Burial

The burial of human cremains with your pet or pets at our cemetery is available. An owner's cremains can be buried here, only after the funeral home has completed their cremation process. Currently, we do have a number of owners buried with their pets.



Pre-need Planning

The services available at the cemetery are: Private Cremation, Private Burial & Group Burial. The burial of human cremains with your pet or pets is available. These services are available for when the need arises or maybe planned out months to years in advance.

Pre-need planning will lock in the desired services & products at current prices, when paid in full. Even if the prices would change the pre-need planning will lock in the price.

If you would like to view the cemetery & discuss the options available for your pet's final needs, feel free to stop by during normal business hours & take a walk around the beautiful grounds.
