Campground Information/Rules

- ☺ **Summer Season:** May 1st to October 15th.
- ☺ **Hours of operation:**
 - **Store:** 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. We may close briefly during the day for our meals/breaks. We may also stay open later on busy nights. When school is still in session, the store will close at 5:00 Sun - Thurs
 - **Quiet Hours:** Sunday–Thursday = 10 pm. – 8 am. Friday – Saturday = 12 am – 8 am.
 - **Recreation Hall:** 8 am to 10 pm. Open until 12 pm Fridays & Saturdays
 - **Pool Hours:** 8 a.m. to dark.
- ☺ **General rules:**
 - All children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult when taking a shower
 - No riding bikes, etc after dark.
 - No crossing others camp sites.
 - Children under 16 must be on their own site after dark or with a responsible adult.
 - Check out time is 11 a.m.
 - No motorized bikes/skateboards allowed.
 - No ATV allowed
 - No chainsaws are allowed to be used on the premises.
 - No cutting trees.
 - Campers who choose to leave early are not entitled to a refund.
 - Per NH Law, alcohol is not allowed in “public areas” thus is not allowed in the area of the pool, recreation hall, and general store but is allowed on individual sites.
- ☺ **Vehicles**
 - Only 1 vehicle allowed per site. All others may park in the designated parking area at the front of the campground.
 - Speed limit: 5 MPH.
 - Vehicle and/or camper washing on campground premises is prohibited.
- ☺ **Pets are welcome however....**
 - They must be on a leash at all times.
 - Campers must clean up after them.
 - Dogs must not be allowed to bark and should not be left alone on the site.
 - No pets are allowed in the pool area.
- ☺ **Visitors:**
 - Visiting hours are 9 a.m. to 10 p.m.
 - Registered campers are responsible for their guests.
 - All visitors must sign in and pay at the store.
 - All visitors must park their cars in the designated parking area at the front of the campground.
- Overnight visitors must check out by 11 a.m. the following day. Visitors staying beyond 11 a.m. must pay for the next day.
- ☺ **Campfires:**
 - Campfires and cooking fires are permitted in the fireplaces provided.
 - Large fires are not permitted. You MUST contain your fires to a reasonable size. (approximately knee high)
 - Do not move the fireplace location. NH Fire Marshals strictly enforce where the fireplaces are and the size of the fires.
- ☺ **Firearms:**
 - Air guns, fireworks, and firearms are not permitted without express written permission from the owners.
- ☺ **Pool:**
 - No jumping, diving, or horseplay in pool area.
 - Children under 14 need to be accompanied by an adult (over 17 years of age).
 - No food allowed inside the pool area.
 - No glass bottles allowed inside the pool area.
- ☺ **Other Seasonal Rules:**
 - **Lawn mowing:** 8 am to 8 pm. Sunday mowing not allowed until 1 pm.
 - Sheds must not be wooden. Sheds must be Rubbermaid plastic or Craftsmen metal and shall not be larger than 10' x 9'. Sheds must be approved by owners. Only 1 shed per site allowed.
 - Deposits for the next camping season shall be due by October 1st. Deposits are not refundable.
 - The balance of payment for seasonal sites must be paid by May 1st of the camping season. Any late payments will be subject to a late fee and/or camper removal.
 - If a seasonal camper chooses to leave before the camping season is over, their payment will not be prorated or refundable.
 - Seasonal sites must be maintained in a neat and orderly fashion. If IRC has to mow the lawn to keep it looking orderly, a minimum of \$25 will be charged.
 - Seasonals are responsible for payment of their property taxes in accordance with NH law and the town of Jefferson
 - Seasonals must activate their own meters by calling Public Service Company of NH, 1-800-662-7764.
 - Seasonals should not have mailed delivered to the campground. If needed, a P.O. Box can be obtained in Jefferson.
