LIGHT HORSE

Rules and Regulations

1. All entry forms must be received before August 23, 2010. Post entries will be charged after August 23, 2010. PLEASE NOTE: Cheque or money order only. **ENSE HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY.**
2. Any animal which appears ill in the opinion of a veterinarian will be asked to leave the grounds.
3. Exhibitors are requested to be on the exhibition grounds by 10 am Thursday September 2, 2010 if at all possible. All animals (with the exception of those entered in the line classes only) must remain on the grounds until the close of the exhibition at 7 pm on Sunday September 5, 2010.
4. Cross-entry will be permitted, if eligible.
5. **BOX STALLS ARE LIMITED. PONIES WILL BE ALLOTTED STRAIGHT STALLS ONLY.** Remaining box stalls will be assigned by the show committee with consideration given to the size of the horse, number of classes entered in, distance travelled and date entry is received. Show committee decision will be final.
6. All exhibitors must be prepared to have their animals measured by a qualified person if requested by the judge.
7. Ponies (14.2 H.H. and under) are barred from entering horse classes and vice versa. Senior riders (18 years old and over) may not show ponies.
8. The ENSE Light Horse Show cannot be held responsible for any loss or injury to horse and/or riders and/or equipment.
9. Classes containing fewer than FOUR entries may be combined or cancelled. Should it become necessary because of time constraints, some classes may be held in the outdoor ring.
10. Owners of STALLIONS, PLEASE INDICATE ON ENTRY FORM. Stallions MAY NOT be shown or handled by an exhibitor under the age of 18 years.
11. Entry fees will be charged for equitation, beginner and showmanship classes BUT NO PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID.
12. Ribbons will be awarded to sixth place, and prize money to fourth place: 1st - \$20, 2nd - \$15, 3rd - \$10, 4th - \$10. Prize money will be paid as follows for sponsored classes. 1st - 30%, 2nd - 25%, 3rd - 20%, 4th - 15%, 5th - 5%, 6th - 5%. Pay outs to Barrels and Poles will be in accordance with M.B.R.A. rules.
13. A fee of \$2 (non-refundable) will be charged for back numbers. One back number per Horse/Rider combination will be issued.
14. All fees for entries, stall, passes and HST **MUST** accompany entry forms. **NO PHONE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!**
15. Entries to be received no later than AUGUST 23, 2010. Any entries received after this date will be considered POST-ENTRIES and post-entry fees must be paid. **POST -ENTRIES ACCEPTED UP TO THE DAY BEFORE THE CLASS. THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.**

17. Exhibitors are expected to be on time for classes. **SCHEDULE IS A GUIDE ONLY.** If tack change is necessary. Please notify Ring Steward beforehand. **DELAYS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
18. AS A COURTESY, please inform Show Office or Ring Steward if you are to scratch from a class.
19. Entries in Horse Barrels and Poles **MUST** be members in good standing with the MBRA and have a MBRA competition back number.
20. Classes included in High Point Pony are as follows. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 17, 18, 24, 44. Classes included in High Point Horse are as follows: 13, 14, 15, 16, 23, 25, 37. Classes included in High Point Gymkhana Pony are as follows: 2 runs each of Class 40 and 41.

HUNTER DIVISION

WORKING HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES - To Jump a course of at least six (6) fences not exceeding three (3) feet in height. To be judged for manners, performance, conformation and soundness. 60 % performance ; 40% conformation.

WORKING HUNTER UNDER SADDLE: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring . At least 8 horses, if available, are required to gallop one way of the ring , but never more than 8 at one time. Light contact with the horse's mouth is permissible.

WORKING HUNTER PONY OVER FENCES: Same requirements as Working Hunter Over Fences (class 1), fences will be adjusted in accordance to height of ponies.

WORKING PONY HUNTER UNDER SADDLE: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. At least 8 ponies, if available, are required to gallop one way of the ring but never more than 8 at one time. Light contact with the pony's mouth is permissible. To be judged on manners, way of going, performance and soundness.

PLEASURE PONY DIVISION

ENGLISH PLEASURE PONY OPEN: To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein. Emphasis to be on manners, tack, and personal appointments to be appropriate to each breed. **NO MARTINGALES, TIE-DOWNS OR DRAW REINS.** Height of ponies and age of riders to be the same as in pony hunter. To be judged 45% performance, 15% conformation and 40% manners.
