

## **EASTERN NOVA SCOTIA EXHIBITION MBRA DIVISION**

**SEPTEMBER 1-3 ,2017**

Entries accompanied by the entry fees must be received by Friday August 18,2017. ENSE will not be accepting entries without payment. ENSE light horse division has the right to refuse any entry. A penalty of \$40.00 will be charged on late entries after this date. Late entries will only be accepted if stabling is available. Cheques payable to Eastern Nova Scotia Exhibition.

With each entry one exhibitor pass will be given. Additional passes will be available for purchase.

Exhibitors must be members and be on good standing of the MBRA and agree to follow the rules, regulations and drug policies of the MBRA.

Proof of liability insurance must be provided with entry form.

Exhibitor arrival time is by Friday by 1:00 pm. Classes are run Friday (barrels at 5:30pm followed by poles), Saturday and Sunday afternoon. Departure time is 6 pm Sunday.

By entering ENSE MBRA show, you agree to honor the rules and regulations specified in the ENSE light horse prize list.

An MBRA approved number must be used to compete. Ring numbers are to be worn and visible in schooling areas as well as the competition arena. Appropriate dress code must be respected by exhibitors. All Junior exhibitors must wear a helmet.

Unsportsmanlike behavior, abusive language and animal abuse will not be tolerated. The exhibitor will be asked to leave the grounds immediately.

Payouts will be in accordance to the MBRA Rules.

Refunds: A refund of 75% will be made on the receipt of a medical certificate from either a veterinarian or medical doctor. This certificate must be received before the start of the first class.

Stabling is limited and will be assigned as the entries are received. Stalls will be allocated and changes may not be made without permission from the show office.

Contact name and phone number must be posted on the front of stall in case of emergency. At the end of show, stalls must be cleaned to the dirt floor.

The ENSE light horse division cannot be held responsible for any loss or injury to horses and or riders and or equipment or tack.

Exhibitors are expected to be on time for their classes. The schedule is only a guide and is subject to change.

The judge's decision is final.

Complaints must be presented to the ENSE light horse office in writing within 24 hours of completion of show accompanied by a \$50.00 deposit, which shall be forfeited if the complaint is not sustained.

No vehicles are permitted on exhibition grounds after 9 am. Vehicles will be towed at owner's expense.

I am aware that approximately 60% of horse related human deaths are caused by head injuries, and that 70% to 80% of these possibilities could have been prevented by proper, approved headgear and it is strongly recommended helmets be worn in all classes. I am also aware that the judge has been instructed not to penalize any rider who decides to compete in approved protective headgear at this show, no matter what the age or discipline of the rider.

I have read the above information and hereby accept the risk associated by my choice to not wear a helmet including but not limited to injury or death. I agree to accept this risk and hold harmless the exhibition, their directors and |volunteers, from and against all claims including any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition; anywhere on the grounds and surrounding area (i.e. practice ring, stable area).
